The evidence of the epure

Sandra Zemor's drawings of Jerusalem are from a rigorous line, of a strength, almost a virility of essential lines. The suspension of her landscapes and of the silhouettes of the city imposes itself on the paper, exactly where it condenses a dream of eternity. In the evidence of the epure beyond time, in an image almost without image and in a space where, even invisible, opens up the horizon and can be perceived the power of abstraction of the people whose Sandra Zemor is both the quardian and the smuggler.
